

To advance through the slideshow:

Move forward one slide by pressing Enter/Return or the right arrow

Move back one slide by pressing Shift+Enter/Return or left arrow

Exit Full Screen view and access Acrobat Reader's interface by pressing Ctrl+L or Command+L



This is a sample introduction slide. This type of image can be created with text and then inserted into the slideshow wherever you want to explain something or give some kind of assignment. I have inserted a Text Panel from the Effects palette and then used the text tool to write this text. You can of course make this as long as possible, but I am going to cut it short because I don't want to cover up my bird (so to speak).



But I can of course skip some space to allow the bird to fly in between the text. **I can also decide to use some other text color to accentuate the text or make it recede into the background.** If I want to reduce the font then I can do that very easily also. *I can also use italic or underline text or I can even strike through text but I cannot for the life of me see why I would want to do that.*

I can do warped text and quite a few other special effects.

Like *rise*

Or fish which looks kind of strange.

Just place your insertion point anyplace on your image and click!
